The way I work

- Using the power of play and experiential learning: In my trainings, learning is internalised through the improv exercises played, first on a subconscious and then a conscious level. Unlike more traditional training methods, participants are directly experiencing change, then verbalising it in the debrief. The best thing about this way of learning is that it does not feel like work; because it's conducted through a series of games, participants become playful and forget that they are in a training.
